
Leadership Pathways: A Journey into Catholic Education

Discerning Catholic School Leadership Program Details

March 5, 2024 - May 7, 2024 - 5 sessions

Rationale: Great public, charter or independent school leadership does not automatically translate into successful Catholic school leadership. Over the course of this program, administrators will grow measurably more knowledgeable about key Catholic School leadership practices. The program's foundation is deepening knowledge, which leads to an environment conducive to peer learning, and community building. This Catholic leadership "discernment journey" will be guided by Catholic school experts associated with CSAANYS and St. John's University School of Education.

Goal: The goal is to assist public school leaders in discerning Catholic school leadership by introducing them to topics that are necessary and important to understanding Catholic schools. We aim to inspire and enrich administrators who are discerning Catholic school leadership with information, resources, and contacts to make the right decision. Hiring committees for Catholic school leadership positions want assurance that a potential school leader understands the differences in leadership responsibilities necessary for a Catholic school.
