Emerging Leaders Institute

Program Details

January 2024 - May 2024

Rationale: Over the course of this program, teachers or other Catholic school personnel will grow measurably more knowledgeable about key Catholic school leadership practices. This program will help develop educators' mindsets with the information they need to lead. The program's foundation is deepening knowledge, which leads to an environment conducive to teamwork, peer learning, and community. This Catholic leadership "discernment journey" will be guided by Catholic school experts associated with CSAANYS and St. John's University School of Education.

Goal: The goal is to assist educators in discerning Catholic school leadership by introducing them to topics such as: managing difficult conversations, delivering effective feedback, school finance, mission, vision, pastoral leadership, etc. We will create a statewide network of future school leaders to grow the ranks from within. The goal is to inspire and enrich teachers who are discerning leadership. Additionally, this program can support those leaders who have joined Catholic schools from other learning institutions, i.e., public schools.

Topics: All sessions will be conducted virtually and will be held from 5 - 6:30 pm

- Community Minded Communication
- It's What We're All About - Charism & Pastoral Leadership
- Transformational Leadership
- Where does the money come from? Beyond the tuition dollars
- Legal and Ethical Issues
- Governance and Policy - how and by whom decisions are made
- Organization, Time Management, Wellness

Session format: Each Zoom session will include information provided by a main presenter with additional input from a panel of principals offering comments, anecdotes, and best practices. Between each session, there is a short written reflection.

Final Project: The cohort will write a book with each member sharing a story, anecdote, or reflection related to one or more aspects learned in each of the sessions.

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
