THE BEGINNING



1972

- Constitution Developed
- Executive Secretary and Field Representative Hired
- \$30,000 budget adopted
- 200 Schools are members
- Mandated Services Act of 1970 prospects "not looking good."

NPS & ED. LAWS



1972

- Annual SAANYS meeting at Lake Kiamesha
 - unanimous approval of resolution which placed SAANYS on record as being in favor of any constitutional aid to NPS.
 - Requested Board of Directors to initiate a change in Ed. Law 3003 & 3004

PARENTS FEDERATION



1972

- Catholic school parents interested in organizing state-wide
- Instructional Use of Computers
- Lunch and Milk Programs

SED LEGISLATION & DIRECTORY



1973

- First Regional Workshops
- NYS Tax Exclusion
- Waiting Supreme Court decision on Mandated Services
- Dog-bird legislation with SED regarding dual enrollment
- Created SED directory for NPS principals

CSAANYS 1ST BIRTHDAY



**APRIL
24, 1973**

- 450 member schools.
- Membership runs for 12 months from renewal

MANDATED SERVICES



1973

- CSAANYS Position on Mandated Services
- Textbook law summary published
- Legislative Bills

CERTIFICATION & TEXTBOOKS



1974

- Public experience to be deleted from Chief School Certification
- Textbook "headache" cured for Rochester Principals

HEALTH SERVICES & TRANSPORTATION



1974

- Equitable Health Services bill signed rendering services to NPS students
- State excise tax for fuel for vehicles used for educational purposes
- 15 mile transportation
- Textbook issues continue

UPDATED LEADERSHIP & PRIORITIES



1975

- Governor Carey declines to name Catholic Schools Week
- Sr. Catherine O'Leary joins CSAANYS
- Better implementation of laws is top priority for CSAANYS

NPS LEGISLATION UPDATES & TUITION SUPPORT



1976

- Confusion at SED of student record ownership and "comparable" education
- Brother Bernard Flood joins CSAANYS as Executive Director
- CSAANYS goes to NCEA Chicago
- Courts curb power of states to regulate NPS
- Federal tuition deduction bill gains support

IRS RULING & ORGANIZED PROTEST



1977

- Catholic schools do not have to file 990, new IRS ruling
- Tuition deduction tax credit bills gain support
- CSAANYS sent letters of protest to Congress and US Education Secretary Boyer re: "downgrading" the office of NPS

CONVOCATION & INCLUSION



1978

- CSAANYS plans first statewide Convocation
- Executive Director appointed to Governor's Conference on Libraries and Advisory Board to the Speaker's Task Force on Sports and Physical Fitness
- Convocation attendees agree it was an "eye-opener"
- CSAANYS proposes legislation for health services to Board of Regents

CONFLICT, DELAYS, LEGISLATION & TESTIMONY



1979

- CSAANYS pinpoints areas of conflict with public schools
- Mandated Services payments delayed, meeting held with SED
- Regents amended regulations
- State and Federal legislation
 - transportation
 - health services for city districts
 - textbooks
 - educational choice
- Brother Flood testifies before Board of Regents
 - gifted and talented
 - health services
 - transportation
 - textbooks
