#### **URGENT - MSA Alert & Calls to Legislators**

the Catholic Recently, Conference posted its second alert on the 2% reduction in Mandated Services Their first alert re-Aid. sulted in nearly 23,000 email messages, letters, and calls to legislators. This response was critical not only in getting legislators to introduce legislation to remedy the situation, but to help Senator Golden and Assemblyman Lentol to advance their bills. However, there are literally thousands of bills being considered and only those that are being pushed heav-

ily will be considered.
