Rooted in the Sisters' charism of *unity, reconciliation, and all-inclusive love*, the academic philosophy of the school emphasizes the intellectual, social, and spiritual growth of each individual young woman. Fostering academic excellence and respect, TMLA seeks to empower young women to realize and value their own unique gifts and talents, and to further use those gifts as leaders in creating a more just and peaceful society. - Reports directly to the school Board of Trustees and Board of Members of the Congregation of Sisters of St. Joseph's (CSJ)

- Develop and execute a comprehensive fundraising strategy to ensure the financial sustainability of the school.
- Establish goals and metrics for fundraising success.
- Cultivate relationships with donors, alumnae, and community partners to secure financial support.
- Evaluate needs and strategies for expected upcoming campaigns,
- Create and implement successful annual giving programs to increase donor participation and dollar amounts.
- Review strategies and resources for grant applications.

- Lead the development and implementation of a comprehensive marketing and branding strategy for the school.
- Collaborate with internal and external stakeholders to create a compelling narrative that aligns with the school's mission and values.

- Strong leadership skills with the ability to inspire and motivate a diverse community.
- Expertise in financial stewardship and fiscal administration
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Fluency in a language other than English that is predominant in NYC, a plus.
